

Our restored pavilion and grounds are now available for private hire

We currently only use our recently restored Pavilion as an indoor seating area at weekends and during school holidays. However, we are also keen for it to be used for recreational, educational and business purposes, both during the day and in the evenings. However, as the Pavilion has not been used as an event space in recent times, we have not yet set fixed rates for its hire. Instead, we would be happy to set the rates on a case by case basis. If you are interested in hiring this unique place you should be aware of the following:

- a) Most of the people coming to the Halfway House will have to walk up the hill on foot whatever the weather (but we can guarantee a warm place all year round and hopefully fabulous views once they reach us).
- b) Hirers should be aware of the nature of the track their guests will need to walk up to ensure appropriate shoes and clothing are worn and that torches could potentially be needed (depending on the time of booking).
- c) The Halfway House team should be able to take up in advance any materials needed for events (this would need to be discussed at the time of initial enquiry). We may also be able to provide a lift for any disabled guests (again, this depends on numbers and would need to be established at the time of enquiry).
- d) We can provide wooden chairs and tables to seat (30) and trestle tables to seat (48) or a combination of wooden chairs and trestle tables.
- e) We can either offer our standard menu (see the menu on our website) or we can organise a buffet for the event.
- f) The Halfway House will always have a limited water supply. Therefore, all our guests will have to use our two portaloos (which we keep in good condition). If an event is planned to have more than 30 guests, then we will add on the cost of obtaining one extra portaloos for every 20 people above this number to any booking quote.
- g) We can provide a hot handwash (e.g. for the cleaning of hands after art activities).
- h) We do have conditions of hire which we will send out to any potential hirer once an initial enquiry form has been completed.
- i) We appreciate that some activities (e.g. yoga, meditation) could take place elsewhere on our site and therefore we do not wish to restrict interest to the Pavilion only.
